His design methodology maximises the relationship between master planning, public space, infrastructure and buildings to ensure the creation of strong and vibrant communities. Pieter's projects concentrate on producing a rich-mix of functions for a varied demographic, with a strong focus on biodiversity to create timeless designs for urban plans including public realm and landscape design.

With his optimistic attitude and team approach, Pieter holds a crucial role within Mecanoo's projects, working to ensure an integrated architecture, landscape and urban planning approach. He believes the human experience and change of use over time form the essential basis for all design projects. Key projects that Pieter has held a pivotal role within include housing projects in the Netherlands and UK such as Cartesiusdriehoek in Utrecht and KAMPUS in Manchester, masterplanning projects including Shenzhen North Station and Den Haag CS, educational typologies such as Manchester Engineering Campus Development and public space design within projects including Natural History Museum Abu Dhabi, De Nederlandsche Bank, Amsterdam, Museum Boijmans van Beuningen, Rotterdam and the roof terrace of the Stavros Niarchos Foundation Library in New York.
