Her work with Mecanoo includes the Library of Birmingham integrated with the REP Theatre; Eurojust; HOME Arts Centre and the highly complex Manchester Engineering Campus Development. Most recently, Carmen has been leading the concept design stage for Mecanoo's renovation of the New York Public Library Midtown Campus. Having been involved in the Library of Birmingham from project onset, Carmen played a pivotal role in project delivery, maintaining high levels of client satisfaction.

In her design approach and client consultation, Carmen leverages attentiveness and strong listening skills in an effort to tease out the nuances in the assignment and produce design solutions that are not only unique to the brief, but also deliver unexpected results.
